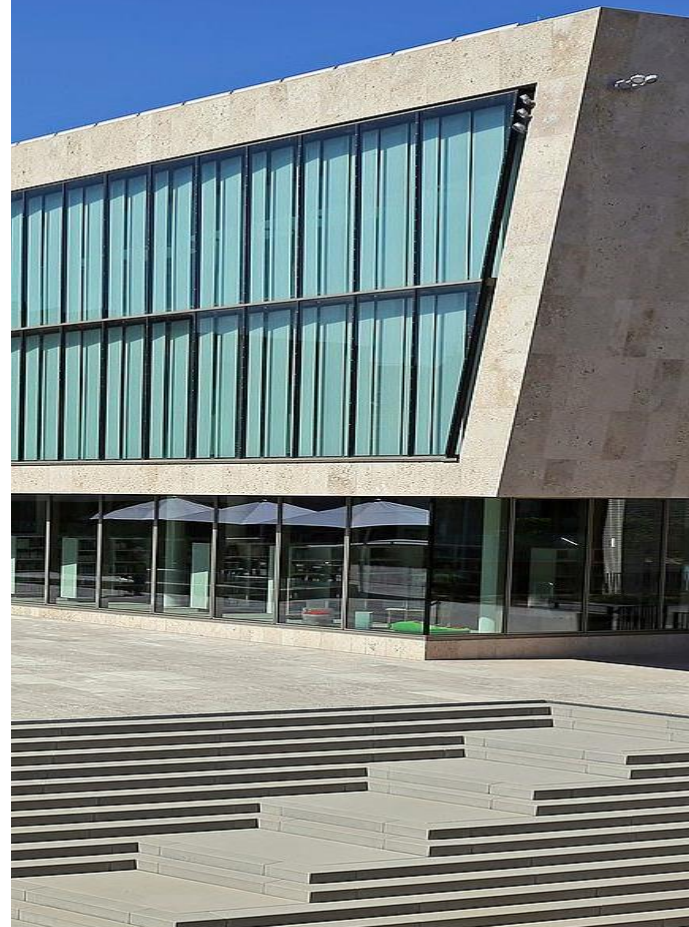

During your studies, you will earn ECTS credits in all courses, once all examination requirements have been passed successfully. 30 credits should be acquired per semester.

Once you have received your acceptance letter from the university, you can start organising a visa. No visa is required for students with citizenship of an EU/EEA country. All you need is a valid identity card or passport.

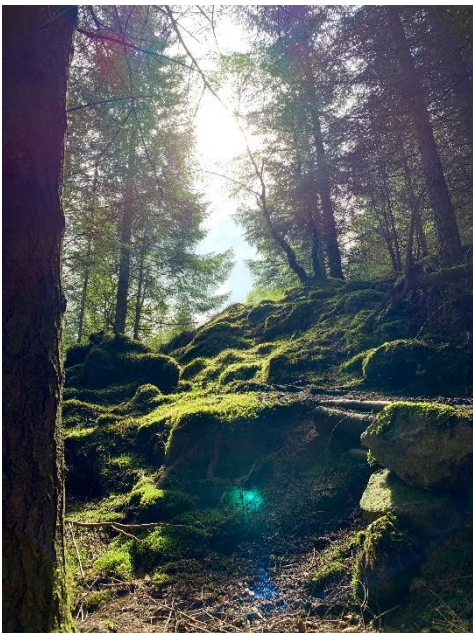
