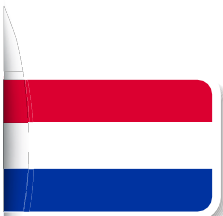
International programmes 2025-2026

International Programmes 2025–2026

CHE offers short programmes in several professional fields. In these programmes you will study alongside Dutch students and get involved with many other cultures. The courses are conducted in English and will all start in September 2025. You can choose a 15 EC programme and finish your studies in November, or choose a 30 EC programme and stay with us until January 2026 (please note: it is not possible to start your studies in November). At this moment, CHE does not offer international programmes in the Spring semester.

30 EC programmes / September 2025 – February 2026

International Strategic Communication & Sustainable Development

Master the art of building 'bridges of understanding' between organizations in an international context where social issues and sustainable development are important.

Sustainable International Business

Understand sustainability challenges and global societal issues related to the field of international business. Develop your intercultural skills. Learn about sustainable business models and the benefits of nation branding.

Sustainable Communities & Domestic Violence / Sustainable Communities & Global Health

Understand problems within the Sustainable Development Goals and how to work towards solutions. During the first part of the programme students follow the course Sustainability & Practical Ethics. For the second part students choose between:

1. **Domestic Violence**, including child abuse & neglect. It is crucial to be aware of the reality of domestic violence, and to know what it can look like. Equally important is to know how to react adequate, to create ways to stop the violence and make home a safe place for all who live there.
2. **Global Health**. What is needed to ensure healthy lives and wellbeing, specifically in low-income settings? Topics include primary health care, tropical diseases, mother child health, health promotion and resource allocation.
