ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Sufficient English language skills to actively participate in the courses and practical training (minimum B1 on European language levels).

Studies in the autumn semester 2018 begin on 3 September and end on 14 December, application deadline 15 May 2018. Studies in the spring semester 2019 begin on 18 February and end on 24 May, application deadline 15 November 2018.
